This letter is offered as the report of investigation activities at the Former Augusta Refinery in accordance with Section X, "Reporting," of the Administrative Order on Consent dated October 24, 2003, Docket No. RCRA-07-2004-0009. This report addresses activities occurring during the period of April 1 through June 30, 2012.

Description of Activities

The proposed conceptual plan for the walnut river AOI was submitted to EPA on April 20, 2012. This document was prepared by Burns & McDonnell, and the title is "Proposed Walnut River Interim Corrective Measure – Conceptual Plan, Walnut River Area of Interest, Former Augusta Refinery, Augusta, Kansas."

On May 23, 2012, Shaw completed the first quarterly Walnut River surface water sampling event in accordance with the Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) for the Walnut River Surface Water, dated November 9, 2011.

On June 22, 2012, confirmation groundwater samples were collected from monitor wells FAR09-01S and FAR09-02S. Monitor well FAR09-03S remained dry and was not sampled.

Summary of All Findings

No VOCs or SVOCs were detected in the surface water samples collected during the Walnut River surface water sampling event. All detected inorganics were less than their respective standard. The surface water sampling methodology and complete sampling results will be provided by Shaw in the Quarterly Walnut River Surface Water Sampling Results letter report.

The groundwater sampling results for FAR09-1S and FAR09-2S have not yet been received from the analytical laboratory and will be provided in the next quarterly update.
