- On April 19, 2013, WPS submitted the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2013 update to EPA.
- On June 19, 2013, WPS was notified by AMEC of pending drainage improvements by the City of Augusta in the general area of the Walnut River AOI. Subsequent conversations indicated that AMEC had spoken to KDHE regarding work in this area and that City of Augusta intends to improve the drainage structure under the levee in the AOI area. The Walnut River AOI Interim Measures will be coordinated with the drainage improvements.
