This letter is offered as the report of investigation activities at the Former Augusta Refinery (FAR) in accordance with Section X, "Reporting," of the Administrative Order on Consent dated October 24, 2003, Docket No. RCRA-07-2004-0009. This report addresses activities occurring during the period of July 1 through September 30, 2013.

Description of Activities

- In correspondence dated September 11, 2013, submitted a Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Work Plan to perform a water balance and LNAPL evaluation at the FAR.
- In correspondence dated September 23, 2013, submitted a Sampling and Analysis Plan Addendum for the proposed 2013 groundwater monitoring event.
- Initiated planning for stabilization of additional surface asphalt identified north of the SWMU 17 cap. Per the prior SWMU 17 stabilization project, the proposed remedy will be coordinated with KDHE Bureau of Waste.

The following activities will be performed or initiated during the next reporting period:

- Complete the proposed groundwater monitoring event.
- Initiate the scope of work to perform an LNAPL monitoring evaluation for the CMS.
- Initiate the scope of work to complete a water balance evaluation for the CMS.
- Submit a scope of work to USEPA to plug and abandon temporary shallow monitor wells installed as part of the RFI field activities.
- Submit a Work Plan to KDHE, with copy to USEPA, for additional asphalt stabilization north of the SWMU 17 cap.
- Submit a Work Plan to EPA for the Walnut River Interim Corrective Measure.
